Our seventh annual spring foraging dinner will take place outside of Glencoe. Star Thrower Farm is home to a flock of pasture raised, pure Icelandic sheep and their guardian llamas.

Rich sheep's milk cheeses are produced at the farm's creamery and beautiful fiber products are produced from the wool of the farm's flock. Our farmer hosts are Deborah and Scott Pikovsky. The event sells out quickly, so reserve early!

Tours and Talks:

We will have several tours and talks, so guests can learn about humane animal husbandry, cheese production, local production of beer and wine, and what makes a healthy farm ecosystem. Tours are in three sessions from 11:00 a.m. to 2 p.m. giving guests the opportunity to participate in each one. Talks & Tours are family friendly!

During this time, sheep cheese from the farm, fruit and bread will be served with a Small-Batch Farmhouse Ale from the Fulton Brewer's Series and local sustainable wines from Crow River Winery.

Picnic Style Dinner:

Our chef is Doug Flicker of Piccolo Restaurant in southwest Minneapolis. Using locally sourced ingredients, the spring meal will feature lamb from the farm and foraged foods from the area. Locally produced wine and beer are included. Buffet service at 2:00 p.m.
